COLOMBIA	 Share with EUROSAI the results of the Working Group on fight against Transnational Corruption (for instance, the Information exchange network, Manual of Good practices) Engage in cooperative audits with participation of SAIs from the 2 regional groups
FRANCE	 European SAI could launch at the same time an audit on each anti- corruption policy, investigating main laws and means to fight corruption and promote public integrity: ad hoc institutions, their powers of investigation, independence, financial means and human resources (recruitment and status), and try to measure efficiency of these policies.
